Louisiana Winter Bird Atlas (January 10 – February 20)

Good news! The WBA has officially been extended for a fourth year and a fifth year is possible. As many of you already know, there are many quads in North Louisiana that have never been birded for the WBA. Maybe you, too, can find a Red-throated Loon or a Little Gull!

To find quads that need birding, log on to <http://ebird.org/content/la/>. Then select "View and Explore Data" followed by "bar charts." Select "Atlas Quadrangles in this state" and hit "Continue." Then, choose the quads you wish to see results quad by quad.

In order to have an accurate picture of birdlife in the state, we need to fill in the current gaps of quads that have not been birded.

You are invited to help count birds during the 12th Annual Great Backyard Bird Count at the Red River National Wildlife Refuge Headquarters in Bossier City. Come walk the trails in the pecan grove or along the river.

Schedule of Activities:

8:00 a.m. until – Breakfast with the Birds. Breakfast bars, shade-grown coffee, hot tea, hot chocolate, and juice.

8:30 a.m. – Bird Walk. Children accompanied by an adult are welcome.

All Day – Feeder watch, walking trails, informal refuge tours.

Rain date: In case of rain, the event will be rescheduled for Saturday, March 7, 2009.

Directions to the refuge: From the intersection of US 71 (Barksdale Boulevard) and Jimmie Davis Highway (LA 511) in Bossier City, go south about one-half mile on US 71/Barksdale Blvd and turn right (west) on Sunflower Road. BIRD REPORT – *compiled February 2, 2009*

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer's initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds they observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.

Report bird records for the newsletter to Mac Hardy by the 15th of each month. All bird records reported here are observations of the observers and are therefore the responsibility of the observer.
