BIRD TALK

Will Smolenski had a **Sharp-shinned Hawk** which caught a **Mourning Dove** and ate it in his backyard. He was surprised that a squirrel was not afraid of the Hawk and actually scared it off to a tree.

Jim Ingold saw a **Cooper's or Sharp-shinned Hawk** at LSUS. He also passed around a photograph showing 7 **Inca Doves** in his backyard.

Charlie Lyon reported an **American Golden Plover** south of Wallace Lake on Ellerbe Road.

Roy Henderson reported a white **Northern Mockingbird**. It has black eyes and beak so does not qualify as a true albino. He passed pictures of this bird around.

Horned Larks and **Barn Owls** are reported in the Yearwood Road area. Members report nest building activity.

Paul Dickson sent word of an albino **Red-tailed Hawk** north of Leonard road.
