## FIELD TRIPS

**November 8 -- C. Bickham Dickson Park in Shreveport.** Wintering woodland birds along the Red River can be expected. See our **Mute Swan** and **Canada Goose** families, but do not count them or turn them in because.....Oh well.....? Ask Will!! Sigh :-). Meet at LSUS parking lot near the Museum of Life Sciences at 7:30 a.m. Leader: Jim Ingold.

**November 15 -- Cross Lake Barge Trip.** Always a favorite trip, we have two trips scheduled this year (Dec. 13th also). A per person fee of \$10 approximately, will cover the cost of barge rental. A sign up sheet will be passed around at the preceding club meeting, as space is limited. Also you may call Chuck or Sally Moffett to sign up for this trip. Meeting place: probably Shreveport Yacht Club. Time: 7:30 a.m. Leader: Chuck and Sally Moffett.

**November 22 -- Cypress Lake Recreational Area and Don Sonnier Catfish Farm.** We should see **Bald Eagles** at the catfish farm or at Cypress Lake Recreation Area. This is the first BSG trip to these two good areas. The mounted waterfowl exhibited in the nature center at Cypress Lake has over 100 birds. It is a good way to learn several species uncommon to our area, and is the most complete collection anywhere around. Meet at the WhatABurger on N. Market St. at 7:00 a.m. Leader: Hubert Hervey.

**December 6 -- Caddo Lake Bird Count.** This count is organized along the same guide-lines as Christmas Bird Counts but is not an official CBC because it is outside the required date limits. It is run by NETFO members and Jim Ingold is our coordinator with NETFO. Sign up, and the

area to be covered by each group will be handled by Jim at the November meeting. We cover the LA portion of the Caddo Lake area. Time: from can to can't. Leader: Jim Ingold.

**December 13 -- Cross Lake Barge Trip #2.** This trip is scheduled to go even if the November trip sails out of port. Yes, two trips in one year! Details are the same as for the November trip, with sign up sheet, fee, etc., required. Remember to dress warmly. Leader: Chuck and Sally Moffett.

**December 20 -- Shreveport Christmas Bird Count.** This is the longest continuous count in the state. The usual count is over 100 species. Feeder watchers and more participants are needed. Coordinator: Charles Lyon.

**January 3, 1998 -- Bossier, Caddo, Bienville Christmas Bird Count.** Now you know what BCBCBC means. This is a popular and productive CBC that has accurately provided data showing the changes in bird species and numbers due to the completion of the Red River Waterway Project. ## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

**B**ill Fontenot received his Master's degree in biology (animal ecology) from Northeast Louisiana State University in 1980. He did post-graduate work in biogeography at University of Alabama in 1981-82. He has worked for the past 12 years with the Lafayette Louisiana Natural History Museum as Curator of Natural Sciences. He and his wife Lydia have owned and operated Prairie Basse, a native plant landscaping and nursery business, since 1988.

Mr. Fontenot has been contributing a column on natural history to the local Lafayette Sunday newspaper since 1986. He is the author of *Native Gardening in the South* and he co-wrote *A Cajun Prairie Restoration Journal* with Drs. Malcolm Vidrine and Charles Allen in 1995.

He is a past president of the Louisiana Native Plant Society and is on the technical advisory board for Louisiana Project Wildflower and the Louisiana office of the Nature Conservancy. He has been an active birder for the past 27 years.

## Peterson Field Guide #49: A Field Guide to Warblers of North America

Buy it! Buy it! Buy it! Now that I've gotten that out of my system, on with the review. The book starts with the obligatory introduction and then gets to the meat of the subject. It begins with a basic overview of warblers, genera, behavior, identification methods, research methods and a "how to use this book" section. Like the other Peterson Guides, the plates are well executed. However, these are all in a single section at the beginning of the book. Unlike other Peterson Guides, there are photos and detailed distribution maps with the descriptive sections. Each warbler has its own section devoted to description, similar species, voice, behavior, habitat, distribution, status and conservation, subspecies, taxonomic relationships, plumages and molts. References are included for each species account, should the reader wish to delve more deeply into that particular bird. Sixty warblers are treated in this fashion. The average birder in the field would have more information than he/she could handle with this book. It is almost twice as thick as the Eastern Birds Field Guide that makes it bulky to carry. However the undertail plates should be a big help with those warblers that are seen only fleetingly from below.

This book is very readable. The information gleaned from the species accounts will be beneficial in learning how to and where to find the warblers. As a reference book or extra guide to bring along, this book is highly recommended. The hardbound copy has been reported to be more durable, which is desirable for reference purposes. We have the soft cover copy, and it seems sturdy enough so far. We found our copy at Tower Bookstore in Shreveport.

Email reports list several mail order sources. Most bookstores will be glad to order a copy for you.
