ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Cecilia Riley is the Executive Director of the Gulf Coast Bird Observatory (GCBO) located in Houston. A native Texan, biologist, and avid bird watcher, Cecilia has committed her life's work to avian research and natural history in both North America and Latin America. Cecilia's educational background includes a B.S. in Ecology from the University of Texas at Arlington and an M.S. in Zoology from the University of Arkansas. Prior to her position at the GCBO, Ms. Riley spent 2 years as the state coordinator for Texas Partners in Flight and 8 years as a research associate of marine studies at the University of Texas Marine Science Institute in Port Aransas. Currently, Cecilia's professional activities and this presentation will focus on the conservation issues associated with migratory songbirds and the ecologically important coastal zone, from Florida to the Yucatan Peninsula of Mexico.

MAY FIELD TRIPS

May 8 - NAMC DAY: Our club has participated in this event since its beginning. The North American Migration Count has become one of our club's favorite outings. This includes **Swainson's** and **Worm-eating Warblers**, two of the most difficult to locate. This year Terry may be able to have the same exceptional luck. Leader: Terry Davis:741-1115. BIRD REPORT DISKS READY

Extra copies of the program and database used to report bird records for the newsletter are available (at no cost!). Birders who use this system provide a great service to the Bird Study Group by providing their birding records in a format that can be easily added to our large database (over 79,000 records!).

If you use a computer to send things to LABIRD but **do not** use a computer database for your bird records then this is for you! By using this system you can enter your observations faster than it would take to type the paragraph you send to LABIRD. You could then post a report of your observations to LABIRD by pasting it into your paragraph. It will look better (than most that I have seen) and you will have more time to work on the prose of your paragraph.

The system comes with complete instructions, the database and program, species lists, and it is all packaged in a snazzy manila envelope, AND will help the BSG a lot.

NEWS ON THE DATABASE

Changes are in the works for the BSG bird database. At least one change will be announced at the next meeting and in the next newsletter. The second change will probably follow shortly after. Don't just sit there, go birding. And during (not after) your birding trip record your observations in a field checklist, a report form, or anywhere else. Be sure to record the specific locality, the date, and the numbers of each species seen. Report your sightings to the BSG by turning in your BSG disk, field checklist, report form, or call it in to a reporter (see newsletter), call it in to the Museum, or e-mail it to lsusmus@prysm.net. Carrier pigeons are not yet an option.

SWAN IN MEXICO

Larry Raymond and I, with our wives, attended the annual meeting of the Southwestern Association of Naturalists (SWAN) in Monterrey, Mexico, last month. We had a great time and heard lots of interesting papers on the biology of the southwest. During the road trip, and at every opportunity during the meetings, we were trying to bird, hoping for some life bird experiences. We had excellent views of several birds that we don't normally get in northwestern Louisiana: **Hooded Oriole**, **Crested Caracara**, **Harris's Hawk**, **Black-throated Sparrow**, **Painted Redstart**, and **Curve-billed Thrasher** to name a few. One of my highlights was seeing a **Long-billed Thrasher**, a common bird that has previously escaped me even though I have been in its range many times. Even though my list of target birds was very extensive, none others emerged. Maybe next time.

LOUISIANA WINTER BIRD FEEDER SURVEY RESULTS IN SUCCESS

[Editor's note: This is the internet article on the winter bird feeder survey, slightly edited and formatted for the newsletter.]

The first annual winter bird feeder survey, conducted Feb. 4-7, 1999, was a great success say Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries biologists. Since this was the first year, LDWF biologists were uncertain about public enthusiasm. The results, however, were very encouraging. More than 200 people from around the state participated by counting birds at their outdoor feeders and recording the data.

A total of 16,311 birds were reported and the most numerous species reported was the **American Goldfinch**, which was seen by 163 surveyors and accounted for 6,466 birds. The most commonly reported species was the **Northern Cardinal** with a total of 899 individuals tallied in 179 reports. In all, 96 species of birds were identified from 39 parishes. The reports were evenly distributed throughout the state. St. Tammany Parish had the most participants at 65 followed by East Baton Rouge with 23, and Calcasieu with 21.

The data collected during the survey will be used over time to predict trends in winter bird populations in Louisiana. Winter bird activity can vary greatly from year to year. By collecting this kind of information and

comparing it to future survey data, Department staff can monitor fluctuations in winter bird numbers.

The survey can also be beneficial in identifying declining bird populations. Many bird species are decreasing in numbers and this type of data may be used in conjunction with other methods to help identify species in peril.

One important side benefit of the survey is the generation of interest in feeding and watching birds and the encouragement of public activity in wildlife conservation efforts. Birdwatching can be a truly rewarding hobby for young and old. It can be quite a challenge and a lot of fun to identify all the birds that visit feeders. Birdwatching is a great way to help teach children about habitat conservation and the importance of a clean environment. Getting a child involved in activities such as LDWF's survey can help foster a lifelong interest in birds.

"The Department wishes to express its thanks to everyone who participated in the survey," said Fur and Refuge Division Administrator Brandt Savoie. He added, "We encourage future participation in this program and others like it."
