The ninth Great Backyard Bird Count (GBBC) is fast approaching! Over the past few years, northwestern Louisiana involvement in the GBBC has increased dramatically due in large part to BSG member participation. In 2005 observers in ten cities and towns in Caddo, DeSoto, Claiborne, and Bossier Parishes turned in reports. Shreveport once again led the list not only in northwestern Louisiana but in Louisiana with 100 species, an excellent total but down from our banner year of 2004 when 116 species were reported. Stonewall followed with 63 species, Homer had 55, Caspiana had 52, and Keithville had 47 species. Other localities reporting for our area included Blanchard, Mansfield, Haughton, Carmel, and Bossier City. The species totals were especially remarkable considering that a number of BSG members spent the better part of the four-day count period at the LOS meeting in Lafayette and points south.

Find out more about BSG activities planned for the GBBC in the February newsletter. The BSG database lists 176 species that have been found in our area in the month of February, including rarities. Download a February (or any other monthly) checklist from the BSG website www.birdstudygroup.org/SelectMoCheck.html. Start scouting your areas now!

To learn more about the count and its significance nationally, go to www.birdsource.org/gbbc. For the first year, awards will be given to localities with the highest number of species, the highest number of birds sighted, and the most checklists submitted. There is also a photo contest. Complete instructions for participation are available on the GBBC website, but the guidelines are simple: For each day of the count period, report the highest number of a particular species recorded at each location you bird. For example, on day one of the count, in your backyard you have one **Northern Cardinal** at 10:00 a.m., five at noon, and two at 2:00 p.m. You report five **Northern Cardinals** for your backyard (the highest number present at one time) for day one. You go birding the same day at Richard Fleming Park, where you spot six cardinals in one location. You report six

Northern Cardinals for Richard Fleming Park. You start all over again for days two, three, and four.

Note: If you do not have access to the internet, call in your list to me or mail it to 503 Haynes Avenue, Shreveport, LA 71105, and I will enter your sightings at the GBBC website. Be sure to include the city or zip code for all sightings.

- Register at the door Friday or Saturday night. Note that field trips are limited to a certain number of participants; there is no guarantee a field trip will still be open at that time.
- Registration forms will also be available at the BSG meeting on Tuesday, January 10, 2006.

Winter Meeting Field Trips:

Field trips are included in your registration fee; there is an additional charge of \$20 per person for the Red River by boat trip. Trips are limited to 12 participants each except for Red River by boat, which is limited to 15 participants. Please pre-register for field trips so that we may make any field trip adjustments that might be needed. Field trip descriptions are available on the BSG website at www.birdstudygroup.org. Click on the link "Just for LOS."

Field trips will depart from the LSUS parking lot nearest to the KDAQ Public Radio tower and the LSUS Museum of Life Sciences. All-day trips will depart LSUS at 7:30 a.m. and return by 5:00 p.m. Morning trips will depart LSUS at 7:30 a.m. and return by 12:00 noon, except for the Bayou Bodcau trips, which will depart at 7:00 a.m., and the Sunday Shreveport Regional Airport trip, which will depart at 8:00 a.m. Afternoon trips will depart at 1:30 p.m. and return by 5:30 p.m., except for the Red River and Cross Lake by boat trips, which will return by 6:00 p.m.

Please bring two-way radios if you have them. Radios are especially important in caravans to keep all vehicles in contact and to allow the leader to alert participants to birds seen along the way.

ALL-DAY TRIPS (LEAVING AT 7:30 A.M.)

Saturday

- Northern Caddo Parish and Caddo Lake (car-side birding and light walking). Bring money for lunch, which will be at a restaurant along the way.
- Cross Lake area and Walter B. Jacobs Memorial Nature Park (car-side birding and light walking). Lunch (sandwiches, drinks, etc.) will be provided at Jacobs Nature Park; bring \$5 to cover the cost.

Sunday

- Red River National Wildlife Refuge Bayou Pierre Unit, Lock and Dam No. 4, Powhatan crawfish ponds, and Natchitoches Parish (car-side birding and light walking). This trip down LA 1 is particularly suitable for participants heading south on Sunday as you'll be partway home. You may leave the trip whenever you like. Bring money for lunch, which will be at a restaurant along the way.

Claiborne 2005: The Fight for Water Rights

The second Claiborne Christmas Bird Count, held on Thursday, December 15, 2005, kicked off the official count season in northwestern Louisiana. The festivities had begun the night before with the *pre*-count (not to be confused with the *post*-count) dinner at the home of our Claiborne Parish hosts, ME (Mary Ellen) and Fred Lewis. We all retired early to our respective lodgings, provided or arranged by ME, and 6:00 a.m. on count day found ME, Jerry Bertrand, Vic Bogosian, and me overlooking a marsh adjoining the D'Arbonne Bayou inlet of Lake Claiborne. We were acting on a tip from ME's Lake Claiborne neighbor, Bob Robinson, to be at this location on the Airport Loop before dawn. As we stood beside the road, the early morning darkness was rent by the incessant calling of thousands of unseen **Wood Ducks**, punctuated by the occasional raucous laugh of a **Mallard** or the quack of a **Gadwall**. As dawn approached, small flocks of ducks began taking off from the marsh, their silhouettes barely visible against the lightening sky, until just after 6:30 a.m. when a massive liftoff took place. Concurrently but hardly coincidentally, a pair of **Barred Owls** emerged from the woods behind us and flew over the marsh. Not seen since the 2003 test count, **Wood Duck** had returned to the count with a vengeance; on our return near sunset for another look at the spectacle, approximately 10,000 Woodies were counted coming in to roost. Intriguingly, only 25 **Wood Ducks** were tallied by other teams during the count, which really makes one wonder where the other 9,975 spent the daylight hours.

Around 8:00 a.m., our team split up as Jerry and Vic departed to put in at Lisbon Landing (a.k.a. the LA 2 boat launch) to bird Lake Claiborne by boat. Before being foiled by outboard trouble in late afternoon, they would rack up four **Bald Eagles**, ranging in age from first-year to third-year birds. The guys took a much-needed early afternoon break from the white-capping lake and the team regrouped long enough to add a fifth

Bald Eagle, an adult that flew along the lakeshore at the end of Tatum Road.

The team of Loice and Sterling Lacy and Pat Bates added one of the few reported records of **Inca Dove** in Claiborne Parish with two doves perched in a tree at the Arlington Cemetery on LA 146. The only other Claiborne Parish sighting of **Inca Dove** in the Bird Study Group database is a 1994 observation by Loice, then Loice Kendrick, 12 miles east of Haynesville.

Jim Ingold and Terry Davis turned in such goodies as **Horned Grebe**, **American Woodcock**, **Greater Roadrunner**, and **Bewick's Wren**, but at the top of the list were their new-to-the-count **Harris's Sparrow** (3 birds) and **Henslow's Sparrow** (1 bird). Jeff Trahan went nutty with nuthatches, **Brown-headed Nuthatches**, that is, with 13 of the 26 reported for the count. Mac Hardy single-handedly found 44 **Wild Turkeys**, the only wild turkeys to be reported by any team. Turkeys participating as members of various teams were not counted.

Rosemary Seidler, Linda Adrion, and Janis Harrison, in addition to searching out a passel of **Eastern Towhees** (17), two **Purple Finches**, and the only **Lincoln's Sparrow** to be reported, also regaled the call-the-count assembly with a wild story about a horse, a rooster that thought he was a horse, and a man with a gun and a pack of dogs, who (the man, not the dogs) had forgotten them from last year's count when he told them they were welcome anytime and to come on up and sit on his porch if he wasn't at home.

Since the test count in 2003, ME and I have had to contend with a few participants, who have mentioned (or more accurately, complained) that their assigned areas lacked either diversity (too many pine trees), bodies of water, or both. In 2004 we generously ceded the LA 2 Lake Claiborne boat launch area to one team, who then had the audacity to mention (complain) that there was almost no water there, as if it were ME's and my fault that the powers-that-be chose 2004 to draw down the lake! Surprisingly, they did not seem to blame this year's drought and the accompanying lack of water on us, at least not to our faces. Perhaps, they have come to understand that what hath been given could also be taken awayeth when the water level someday returneth to normal.

To Mac Hardy's credit, he did only mention rather than complain about his 2004 area's lack of water, unlike some people we know. In our continuing munificence, ME and I once again carved out a section of our territory with a view of the lake and donated it to Mac. Unfortunately, Mac said there were no birds to be found on his section of the lake. What more can we do? We give away choice pieces of real estate to other teams;

we *let* Jim and Terry find a **Henslow's Sparrow** on Arizona Road (ME's and my territory, of course). This constant gerrymandering has got to stop! At least until next year, that is. Join us in Claiborne Parish in 2006 for the continuing saga.

Postscript: Species count for 2005 was 96, up from 87 in 2004. Total species for the test count year of 2003 was 75.

BIRD REPORT – compiled December 31, 2005

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer's initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds they observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.

Report bird records for the newsletter to Mac Hardy by the 15th of each month. All bird records reported here are observations of the observers and are therefore the responsibility of the observer.
