UPCOMING FIELD TRIPS AND EVENTS

Beginning birders are welcome on all field trips. Membership in the BSG is encouraged but is not required for participation in field trips. Field trips will **LEAVE** the designated meeting place at the time posted for each field trip. Plan to arrive early for field trip orientation and any carpooling/caravanning arrangements.

What to bring on field trips: binoculars, two-way radios, scope, if you have one, snacks, and drinks. Unless otherwise noted, field trips will take place rain or shine, so bring rain gear if the weather's threatening.

BAYOU PIERRE WMA DESOTO PARISH UNIT DUCKS AND OWLS

Meet in the southwest corner of the Home Depot parking lot on Bert Kouns Loop at I-49. Note the afternoon starting time. You may have seen Hubert's posts about this area, which was the destination for one of the LOS field trips. Expect ducks and **Barred Owl** at the WMA, after which the trip will visit a couple of other locations to search for **Barn Owl**, **Eastern Screech-Owl**, and **Great Horned Owl**.

In Louisiana, unless you are under 16 or turned 60 before June 1, 2000, you must have a valid Wild Louisiana license or Louisiana hunting or fishing license issued by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife & Fisheries to enter a WMA (Wildlife Management Area). An annual Wild Louisiana license is \$5.00 for both residents and non-residents; a one-day pass is \$2.00.

LOUISIANA ORNITHOLOGICAL SOCIETY (LOS) SPRING MEETING, GRAND ISLE, LA

Friday, April 28 – Saturday, April 29, 2006

Information and registration forms for the annual spring meeting are or will be available at the LOS website at <http://losbird.org/meeting.htm>. Due to ongoing hurricane recovery efforts in Cameron Parish, this year's spring meeting will be held in Grand Isle, Louisiana. Grand Isle was hard hit by both Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, but rebuilding is underway. Membership in LOS is not required to participate in any of the LOS meetings, but you are encouraged to join to support the activities of our state society. Annual dues are \$20 for a regular membership and \$25 for a family membership. Three meetings are held each year with programs on Friday and Saturday nights, organized field trips on Saturday and, for the winter meeting, also on Sunday, and a banquet on Saturday night. The spring meeting is the last weekend in April; the fall meeting is the last weekend in October; and the winter meeting is held in different locations around the state, usually the last weekend in January.

Great Backyard Bird Count of 2006 Results

Once again, northwestern Louisiana birders made an outstanding showing in the annual Great Backyard Bird Count held this year from Friday, February 17, through Monday, February 20. Kudos to all of you who braved icy winds and temperatures in the 20's to search out the birds. Three northwestern Louisiana cities and towns made the Louisiana Top Ten list with Shreveport in first place for the fifth straight year with 105 species, Homer in fourth place with 71 species, and Stonewall in ninth with 55 species. Bossier City at 53 species missed tying Farmerville for tenth place by one species.

Shreveport led the state in individual numbers of the following species: **Gadwall, American Wigeon, Northern Shoveler, Redhead, Ring-necked Duck, Pied-billed Grebe, American White Pelican, Great Blue Heron** (tie with Lafayette), **Sharp-shinned Hawk, Red-shouldered Hawk** (tie with Lafayette and Sunset), **Red-tailed Hawk, American Kestrel, American Coot, Greater Yellowlegs, Wilson's Snipe, Bonaparte's Gull, Mourning Dove, Great Horned Owl** (tie with Amelia), **Broad-tailed Hummingbird, Red-bellied Woodpecker, Yellow-bellied Sapsucker, Downy Woodpecker, Northern Flicker, Eastern Phoebe, Carolina Chickadee, Tufted Titmouse, White-breasted Nuthatch, Brown-headed Nuthatch, Carolina Wren, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, Northern Mockingbird, Brown Thrasher, American Pipit, Chipping Sparrow, Vesper Sparrow, Lark Sparrow, White-throated Sparrow, White-crowned Sparrow, Northern Cardinal, Red-winged Blackbird, Eastern Meadowlark, Common Grackle, Purple Finch, Pine Siskin, American Goldfinch**, and reported the only **Lapland Longspurs** in Louisiana.

Homer in Claiborne Parish reported the highest counts of **Wood Duck, Bufflehead, Ruddy Duck, Blue-headed Vireo, Hermit Thrush, Pine Warbler**, and **Dark-eyed Junco**. Williams in Red River Parish led in **Green-winged Teal** and **American Robin** and was the only location in Louisiana to report **Lincoln's Sparrow**. Belcher led in **Eurasian Collared-Dove** and **Fox Sparrow**; Grand Bayou with two owls tied for **Barn Owl**. The dubious honor of the most **European Starlings** recorded goes to Keithville. Stonewall reported more **Field Sparrows** than any other location.

Elm Grove and Williams were the only locations in Louisiana with **Sora**; Elm Grove reported the only **Short-eared Owl**; Bossier City had one of the two

Sedge Wrens reported. Gilliam with two and Shreveport with one reported the only **Sprague's Pipits**; Gilliam also had the most **Savannah Sparrows** and **LeConte's Sparrows**.

You can see complete results by city and parish on the chart included in this newsletter. Remember when considering total individual birds reported that the count took place over a four-day period. For example, if four **Purple Finches** are reported for a location, the same individual may have been seen on four consecutive days or there may have been two, three, or even four different **Purple Finches**.

Nicaraga Bird Trip is ON!

Plans are developing for our excursion to the Finca El Bosque Biological Station (McPherson wilds) of Nicaragua. This is the farm of Brad McPherson (retired biology faculty member from Centenary College) and is located about 7 miles east of Jinotepe. With a view of Concepcion Volcano to the east this mountain top retreat has good bird watching from the back porch, including tinamous, parrots, and several hummingbirds. We will be there during the beginning of the rainy season which means that we might have a little rain daily or not. However, it certainly means that plants will be flowering and there should be an increase in animal activity after the lengthy dry season.

We will stay in a new dormitory that has 13 beds and several showers and bathrooms. The daily cost for the station is \$12 per person per day for room and board. Eight persons have bought their airline tickets, so there are five more spaces available. More spots could be available but someone (numbers 14 and above) will have to sleep on the floor or in a hammock. Most of us will depart Shreveport on May 22 and arrive back in Shreveport on June 2, via Delta with a connection in Atlanta.

If you are interested contact Mac or Amanda (797-5338; lhardy@lsus.edu; acrnkovi@lsus.edu) so we can keep track of the head count.

Everyone will need a passport for this trip. If you have one, be sure to check the expiration date. If you do not have a passport you need to apply NOW. The passport web site is: www.travel.state.gov/passport/ The main Post Office in Shreveport is a passport application facility for in-person applications. Forms are available at the above address. It will take at least six weeks and a mail delay could extend that. Do not take a chance, start now.

Bird Talk – Jim Ingold reported an adult **Bald Eagle** at Bickham Dickson Park. Lois Marts has a juvenile **Red-winged Blackbird** visiting the feeders in her yard. Linda Adrion has been seeing many **Red-tailed Hawks** in northern Caddo Parish. Nancy Menasco said that a **Bald Eagle** often sits on the back side of Buzzard Island on Caddo Lake. She also saw many Great Blue Herons nesting on the island. Susan Martin reported a Brown Creeper at her house in Broadmoor.

BIRD REPORT – compiled March 4, 2005

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer's initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds they observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.

Report bird records for the newsletter to Mac Hardy by the 15th of each month. All bird records reported here are observations of the observers and are therefore the responsibility of the observer.
